Cyber Terrorism

With recent hacking threats prominent in the media every credit union should hear what Mike Saylor from the Texas Credit Union League has to say about Cyber Terrorism. Mike will share about the evolution of terrorism with cyber capabilities, such as targeting critical infrastructure systems, hacking military weapons and vehicles, and leveraging mature hacker financing techniques to fund terrorism activities. The presentation will also include evolving offensive information warfare and effects based operations techniques being employed to combat cyber terrorism.

Mike possesses over 19 years of diversified technology experience with both domestic and international companies in CyberSecurity and Investigations, IT Audit, Compliance and Risk Management, and IT Operations. His experience covers numerous industries, including Financial, Manufacturing, Energy, Telecom, Healthcare, Education, and Retail. Mike is President Emeritus for North Texas FBI Infragard, and Executive Director of the U.S. Cyber Defense Lab at UT Dallas, and member of the North Texas Crime Commission's Cyber Crime Committee and a guest lecturer on topics of Cyber Security, Computer Science, Digital Forensics, IT Audit, and Criminology for North Texas Universities and Community Colleges. His undergraduate degree is in Information Systems from the University of Texas at Arlington, and his Masters degree is in Criminal Justice from the University of Texas at Dallas.
